Abstract Guidelines AYURCON 2026

Structure (mandatory headings):

- Background – Brief context and rationale
- Objectives – Aim of the study/review/case
- Methods – Study design, data source, or review methodology used (for case presentations: patient history, diagnosis, treatment protocol)
- Results – Key findings (even if preliminary, for case studies/reviews)
- Conclusion – Clinical/scientific significance

Rules

Word limit:

- Paper Presentation - **250–300** words
- Poster Presentation - **150–200** words
- Case Presentation - **150–300** words
- Include **3–5 keywords**
- **Title should clearly indicate the nature of the work** (original research / systematic review / case series / conceptual study / poster / case report)
